EXTENDED STUDY

Graduate Opera Workshop

Movement for the Actor

One year of study at The Goodman School of Drama, DePaul University, Chicago, Illinois. Instructors: Betsy Hamilton, Gabriel Halpern, Michael Sokoloff, and Jim Ostelhoff. Consisting of Yoga, Stage Combat, Grotowski, and character study through movement to develop kinesthetic awareness during role preparation.

Voice and Speech for the Actor

One year of study at The Goodman School of Drama, DePaul University, Instructor Peter Wittrock. The use of physical and vocal exercises to project the vocal instrument, increase dynamic range, improve diction & flexibility of entire physical instrument.

Scene Study for the Actor

Ten years of total study: Chris O'Brien (Charles Conrad Acting Studio, Los Angeles); Peter Henry Schroeder (The Actors Workshop, Los Angeles); Jim Ostelhoff (The Good man School of Drama, Chicago); Charlie Suggs and Carveth Osterhaus (Oklahoma City University); Dr. Lloyd Hansen and Dr. Wesley Balk (Northern Arizona University, Flagstaff). Classes mostly based on Meisner technique, Strasberg, and Stanislavsky.

Objectives: To look at the characters within a script and prepare a role based on information given and the actor's creative imagination. Exercises from Stanislavsky's chart as well as Charles Conrad's "sight-reading" and Meisner exercises.
